Alcohol Use Agreement

The Michigan Crossroads Council, Inc., Scouting America or any of its subsidiary councils (collectively, the "MCC") is not liable for any incident, injury including death, or property damage relating to the consumption of alcohol (liquor/beer/wine) on an MCC property.

In addition to the foregoing, the undersigned agrees as follows:

- Alcohol will not be consumed on an MCC Property by anyone under the age of 21.
- Alcohol is to be consumed only in designated areas depending on the type of rental contract situation. During
 family/group conference room, campsite or cabin rentals, alcohol is to be consumed only in the family/group designated
 conference room, campsites, or cabin areas. For special events such as weddings, alcohol may be permitted in
 designated areas such as the dining hall, as per the rental contract.
- Alcohol must be served by a licensed caterer for any event, such as a wedding. If alcohol is served, guest/group must
 use a caterer licensed by the State of Michigan. The guest/caterer must provide the event manager with a copy of
 his/her license at least two weeks prior to the event.
- No alcohol is permitted beyond the designated areas at any time.
- Alcohol must be stored in the conference room, campsite area/accommodation unless other arrangements have been
 made ahead of time in the rental contract. For the safety of minors and other guests, alcohol products must be stored
 securely, out of sight and with no access by minors and other guests.
- Alcohol must be used responsibly and in moderation. Quiet Hours are from 10:00pm to 7:00am. Empty containers and bottles as well as any remaining alcohol must be taken off site by the renters when they leave the property.
- All alcohol (liquor/beer/wine) must not be left unattended, nor left out on tables. All alcohol (liquor/beer/wine) must be
 placed in a locked room, camper, cabin, or vehicle during overnight hours.
- Guest(s) upon becoming aware of a situation that could lead to disorder, injury or property damage shall take immediate and decisive action to prevent guest's from engaging in activities or conduct that is drunken, riotous, quarrelsome, violent, or disorderly, which could cause property damage and/or harm to themselves or others.
- Guest(s) is/are responsible for the safety and sobriety of the persons visiting the property and will be held legally
 responsible for injuries and damages arising from actions which include serving someone to intoxication, serving or
 allowing someone who is already intoxicated, serving minors, and failing to prevent impaired individuals from driving.

The undersigned has read and agrees to the rules and requirements of the Alcohol Use Agreement for MCC Camp Properties. The undersigned will, as the group leader, enforce the MCC Rules and protect the safety of the undersigned's participants, guests, and staff.
